



Can I **write** something?
What is **writing** exactly?

"He who writes two letters of the alphabet with his right or with his left hand, whether of one kind or two kinds, if they are written with different inks or in different languages - is guilty. Even if he should write two letters from forgetfulness, he is guilty, whether he has written them with ink or with paint, red chalk, vitriol, or anything which makes a permanent mark. Also he that writes on two walls that form an angle, or on two tablets of his account book so that they can be read together is guilty...But, if anyone writes with dark fluid, with fruit juice, or in the dust of the road, or in sand or in anything which does not make a permanent mark, he is not guilty. ... If he writes one letter on the ground, and one on the wall of the house, or on two pages of a book, so that they cannot be read together, he is not guilty."

"In reality, you will have to live with the consequences of the offender's sin whether you forgive that person or not...The only real choice is to live with those consequences in the bondage of bitterness or in the freedom of forgiveness...if [a person] has hurt you so badly that you can't forgive them and move past it, they are still hurting you." (Neal Anderson)

"Jesus, I want to choose this path of forgiveness, and I choose to forgive ___ for ___. Now please do a supernatural work of healing in my heart"

EXAMPLE 1: Someone slaps us, turn the other cheek.
PRINCIPLE: If someone offends us personally, seek a personal peace – let Him be the judge!
WE'RE TAKEN CARE OF!

EXAMPLE 2: Somebody sees us for our tunic, give him our cloak.
PRINCIPLE: Why shouldn't we go a step further to help?
WE'RE TAKEN CARE OF!

EXAMPLE 3: Someone forces us to carry stuff for a mile – do an extra one.






